

Position Title: Reuse Specialist

Hours/Week: 30 to 40 hours/week, preference to those who can commit to Saturday and/or Sunday

Purpose: Home Resource is a non-profit organization that seeks to reduce waste, build healthy communities, and promote a more vibrant and sustainable local economy through building materials reuse. The Reuse Specialist will learn and employ wide ranging skills regarding sorting and stocking, basic construction, building material identification and reuse in a business that engages community while contributing to a sustainable economy.

Basic Activities: Including (but not limited to): evaluating donated materials according to current acceptance policies; processing, sorting, and stocking public donations; maintaining orderly/safe storage of materials in the warehouse, lumber yard, and paint shed; assisting customers in transporting purchased materials and answering questions regarding material availability, location, and the mission of the organization.

Essential Qualifications: Ability to interact with people of diverse cultural and economic backgrounds in a respectful, positive manner; ability to remain calm and positive in a fast-paced work environment; knowledge of construction materials and techniques; ability to lift 50 lbs.; and remain aware of customer/worker safety despite uneven ground and irregular storage facilities; commitment to resource conservation; willingness to work hard and learn new skills, and ability to work independently and as a team. Successful applicants will be required to comply with policies outlined in the Home ReSource Employee Manual.

Preferred Qualifications: Experience in customer service in a busy retail environment, forklift and power tools operation, building materials use and practices, and basic computer programs and Point of Sale. Excellent people skills, ability to manage volunteers, direct self and others work to toward store goals and organizational mission, enforce safety and other policies, strong written, verbal and math skills; MT driver's license.
