Youth Interns will be working in our yard, accepting and processing donations, providing customer service, and assisting with department clean ups. They will also be meeting with other sustainability oriented organizations to learn about their programs.

Essential Functions:

- Be able to be on your feet and moving for long periods of time (at least 4 hours a day) in all weather conditions
- Ability to learn to recognize and maintain a safe working environment
- Able to lift and move heavy or awkward building materials

Pay and Hours: \$12 / hour, 8 hours a week for an 8-week term. Term will run from April 4th - May 25th, 2024. Our schedule is Thursdays and Fridays from 4:00 PM - 6:00 PM and Saturdays from 11:00 AM - 3:00 PM. Start times on weekday workdays may vary based on when you get out of school.
