Your PC is “not” eWaste... Use Linux!



Microsoft has discontinued all security and feature updates to Windows 10! While we all use computers, whether it's frequently or just periodically; it is very risky to use these computers “unprotected” from new viruses and malware.

What to do about it?

This **Lunch & Learn** will focus on an alternative to Windows, using your existing computer hardware. No eWaste here! The alternative is **Linux** – a “free” secure alternative to Windows – that receives continuous updates.

What do I need to know?

If you do purchase a new PC, your options are to recycle the old one or worse yet, throw it away So keep your existing PC and install **Linux** on it.

Keep your current PC investment – things to think about!

- Linux should work with everything on your local network.
- Apps on Linux are somewhat comparable to your familiar Windows apps.
- Apps on Linux are “open sourced” – freedom from a corporate structure.
- You do need to spend time learning how your new apps work with Linux.
- Remember: Linux is not Windows – it's different but familiar.
